## Add-a-Step

If you are pulling a tall trailer or if your motorhome's step is too tall for comfort, then take a look at the new Add-a-Step from South Side RV Sales. Built for travel trailers, fifth wheels, toy haulers and motorhomes with entry/exit steps that are more than 10 inches from the ground, the Add-a-Step easily attaches to the RV's bottom step to lower it by almost eight inches.

It is specially designed to attach to the various original equipment steps used with today's RVs. The Add-a-Step is constructed of steel and is reinforced to withstand loads up to 575 pounds.

Each step features a non-skid, perforated metal tread surface for safety and practicality so that loose dirt, mud and other debris fall through to the ground. It weighs less than 11 pounds and stows easily in the RV or tow vehicle for transport. Priced to sell at \$89.95 for the motorhome version and \$79.95 for the trailer unit.

## Oxygenics Shower Head

Let's face it, the shower head in most RVs just don't put out the pressure and spray we want. Wimpy would be the term for what we normally get, so the folks at Oxygenics have developed the Body Spa Skin-Care hand-held or wall-mounted shower head.

The Body Spa produces a satisfying, full-pressure spray with only 20 pounds of water pressure going into it. Since a normal RV water pump puts out about 40 pounds of pressure, it is difficult to tell the difference between the Body Spa unit and your home shower. Available from RV stores in chrome, brushed nickel and gold, Body Spa prices range from \$49.95 to \$55.
